Odstock Parish Council

The Odstock Parish Council has recently completed the installation of kissing gates on the section of the Avon Valley Footpath that runs through the Parish. In total ten new gates have been installed, seven of which were fitted by Parish Councillors themselves. As well as benefitting long distance walkers, hopefully locals will find these paths much more user friendly, especially the elderly, infirm and those with young children or dogs.

Restoration work has now been completed to Jubilee Gardens to prevent further erosion to the river bank and to generally improve the Garden. As with all similar projects, the areas where a mechanical digger was used suffered ground disturbance but it is now beginning to recover and the newly sown grass seed is growing well. We plan to install an additional picnic table in the Gardens, in the near future, beside the pollarded willow.

The Council is considering the feasibility of a Community Orchard in the Nunton Field to the side of the Pavilion. This area is about one third of an acre and could be a resource to be used by the local community not only for the provision of fruit and nuts but also provide a very pleasant amenity area with benches, perhaps to while away a pleasant summer's afternoon. I would like to see rarer, perhaps 'threatened' varieties planted as well as the widely known varieties. Apples, pears, plums and nut trees as well as some more unusual varieties such as Mulberry, fig and Medlar could be planted, subject to the soil conditions being suitable. I am hoping that individual Parishioners might like to sponsor a tree, perhaps in memory of someone or commemorating a significant family event, for instance. Although sponsors would not own the tree, a plaque naming the sponsor and a dedication would be placed at the base of each tree. The Council would value any feedback you might like to give on this idea as without your backing this proposed scheme will not be carried forward.

We have plans to upgrade the Odstock Playground with additional equipment in the future. However, this is dependent upon the sourcing of external funding from grants in addition to money that we have earmarked from our own funds. Councillor Gavin Simmonite is hard at work on this project and I am sure would welcome any support, in whatever form, that you might be able to give.
