From Revd Jenny Taylor

As I write this, the whole country is in shock at the murder of Jo Cox – MP, Wife and Mother. It was the most ghastly act for reasons we do not yet know and an act that has deprived the nation (whatever your politics) of a great talent, and has deprived a family of a wife and mother.

As you read this, the results of the Referendum will be known, and we will be either still in Europe or beginning the process to leave. The recriminations will no doubt be flying and there will be pockets of hurt, disappointment and anxiety. I hope there won't be triumphalism because we now have to try and move forward as a nation with one goal - of creating a safe and secure future for our children and grandchildren.

The Archbishop of Canterbury has already written that "after the referendum we must come together as one people to make the solution we choose work well. Hard words must not create enduring bitterness. Those who have led both sides have done so with courage and determination. Whatever the outcome the Church of England will continue to love and support communities and nation as it always has done, and will seek the greatest human flourishing for all."

As Christians, we are compelled to strive for peace, for justice, for reconciliation, for care of the poor, the stranger, the friendless. We are needed more than ever in our communities, our villages and our nation.

One of my very favourite hymns is Lord for the years by Timothy Dudley Smith – himself, 90 this year. The last verse says: *Lord, for ourselves; in living power remake us, self on the cross and Christ upon the throne; past put behind us, for the future take us, Lord of our lives, to live for Christ alone.* They are good and resounding words; hold them fast as we move forwards together, and let us all, the Archbishop said, "pray that we will reunite with immense determination to be a gift to the world of today and to future generations."

Claire Brown Appeal

Claire Brown, who was born and brought up in Odstock, has been diagnosed with a spinal injury and Functional Neurological Disorder (FND) with Tremor. Claire's consultant has advised she needs more treatment but must find her own funding. She has to raise £50,000, and is about a quarter of the way there.

FND is caused by a problem with the functioning of the nervous system and is thought to derive from the brain's inability to send and receive signals properly. This then causes abnormalities between planning a movement and carrying it out. This leaves Claire unable to walk unaided, and with chronic pain and shakes throughout her body. It also affects her memory, speech and eyesight.

At long last we have secured Faculty approval, as well as a slightly earlier Interim Faculty, authorising essential repairs to the suspended timber floor in the nave of the church. Since the beginning of February the nave has been closed. However all services have continued as usual, although confined to the chancel, access to which is through the vestry via the side door adjoining Church Lane, because the main entrance also has been sealed off for the time being.

Our original plans to complete the work before Easter were thwarted and most unfortunately, but inevitably, our contractor now has a full order book and there will be a further delay before construction of the new floor can begin. At present, our best guess is that the project will be completed in October. Meanwhile, visitors from other parishes will continue to be very welcome to join in our worship – it is very cosy and the nave without a floor is quite a sight!




