Message from Rick Williams (cont.)

.....That discovery is a hard one for anybody. If you set yourself a specific target, and pin your hopes and dreams on it, it is hard for anything else not to feel like failure.

But here's the good news. Our God is a god of second chances. People talk of God having a plan for our lives, and I'm sure he does. But I think God's plans always start from where we are now.

One Bible story particularly brought that home to me. In the Old Testament, the people of Israel were told that they didn't need kings, because God himself was their king. For some time, they managed without a king, and whenever there was a particular need for strong leadership, God would raise up a leader for that occasion (these are the people known in the Bible as "Judges"). But it always felt a bit nerve-racking, especially for a people constantly under attack. They wanted a permanent king, somebody with a standing army who would be able to defend them at the drop of a hat if they were attacked. So they asked the prophet Samuel to appoint for them "a king, like the other nations". Samuel knew this was not what God wanted... that it showed a lack of trust that God would raise up a leader when needed. But God said, "If that's what they want, let them have it".

But amazingly, he did more than that. Even though kingship wasn't his first choice, God chose to bless it. He promised King David that he would always have a descendent as King. He fulfilled that promise in a most remarkable way... by sending his son, Jesus, to be a descendent of King David and an eternal king. (The title "Christ" means "the anointed one"... that was how kings were marked out in those days, so it is the equivalent in our modern times to calling him "the crowned one"... whenever we say "Jesus Christ", we are effectively saying "King Jesus"). Isn't that amazing? God's original plan was that Israel should have no kings as he was their king. But when they demanded a king, he not only allowed them their request, but blessed it by sending Jesus. But of course, in doing so he also achieved the original plan... Jesus is God, so once again, God himself is the only king!

You may not be particularly interested in Old Testament history. But what it reveals here is a God who can take a second choice and bless it so that it becomes as good as the first choice would have been. And if you are somebody for whom life has not gone to script, perhaps through not getting the university or college place you wanted, perhaps for some other reason, that should be a source of comfort. God's plan for your life has not been ruined, because his plan for your life starts today, and it starts from where you are.

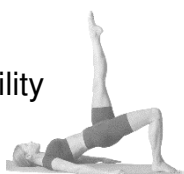

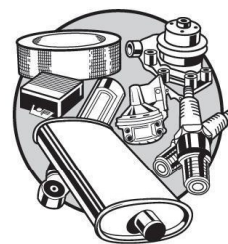

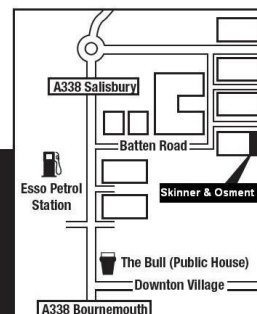
