Incidentally, in case you're not a fan of cryptic crosswords and, therefore, haven't worked it out, the title of this piece includes my two cryptic-style clues for *shovel*;

- push = *shove*, left = *L*, making a word which can mean *to move earth*
- shack = *hovel* beside *S* for south, making a word which can mean *to dig*.

Our speaker was Jeana Ireland who spoke about females in prison. Having been a prison officer at a new female unit at Winchester Prison in the 1990s she had first-hand experience of how and why women offended and their daily routine and experiences. She read some moving accounts, written by inmates, of why they got involved in crime and how they felt about themselves and their situations. This was quite an eye opening talk for most of us.

Lastly members had an enjoyable, and rain free, day for the summer outing to Clarks Village and Montacute House and garden in Somerset.

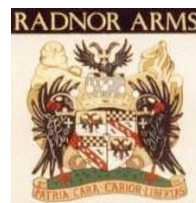
Radnor Hall Show - 2016

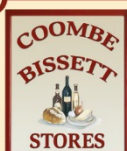

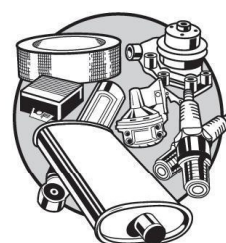

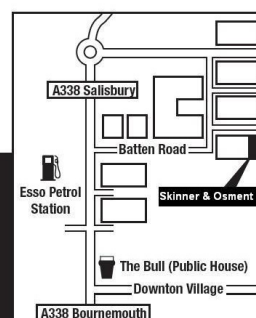
