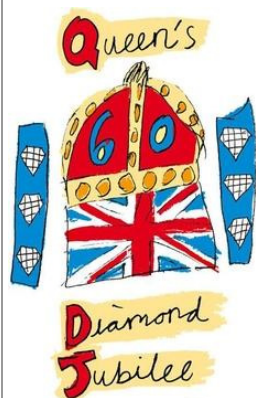

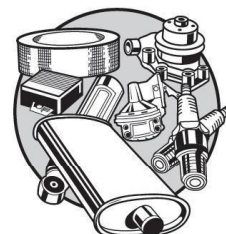

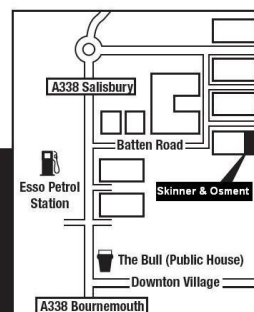

Doorstep traders

Local Police have received increased recent reports of door to door sellers visiting our area; typically these are young males carrying large bags and selling household goods. These sellers often claim to be operating as part of a 'young offenders scheme' but, although many do have a criminal history, they are not involved in any official 'rehab' schemes, just making money for themselves and a controlling boss. These males operate in groups, usually from the north of the country, and are ferried around in minibuses and then dropped off in ones and twos in villages.

We have had examples where they have been extremely pushy, particularly with older/vulnerable residents. In general, they are extremely unwanted and Police do all that they can to disrupt/discourage them.

Anyone selling door to door should hold a valid 'pedlars certificate' from the police – these groups won't usually have one but will show generic photo ID. Residents who do answer the door to these sellers should ask to see the Pedlars Certificate (it should have those words written on it). If traders call at your door without a valid certificate you should inform Police by dialling 101. Consider dialling 999 if any person is abusive, threatening or aggressive.

Older or more vulnerable residents should not open the door to unexpected callers whom they do not recognise. Police can supply 'Stay out stranger' stickers which can be placed on the inside of the door as a reminder not to open the door in these circumstances. A supply will be made available to collect from Downton Library.
