Colin is a charismatic speaker and the Diocesan Social Justice Programme Manager, and he will talk on the impacts of social injustice, hidden poverty and how small changes in life can have a devastating effect. We hope that this will help us all recognise needs in our own communities.

## **Chalke Valley Lent Project**

Every year we have a Lent Project - a charity that we have chosen to support and by joining resources we aim to raise sufficient funds to really make a difference. This year we have selected ALABARE, and specifically their work with Veterans in Salisbury.



Their Wiltshire Home for Veterans offers housing and support to ex-Service personnel who are homeless or are at risk of becoming homeless. All residents must have served in the British Armed Forces.

This is a new service consisting of a 4-bed house and two 3-bed properties in Salisbury, housing up to 10 people at any one time. The levels of support can be varied to help veterans through more difficult times, but also provide less support so they can live more independently to help gain the skills needed to maintain their own home. Every veteran has a key worker, to help create and agree a support plan based on individual needs.

The veterans service requires significant investment to create, develop and to run and maintain on a daily basis.



## Chalke Valley 'Stations of the Cross' Pilgrimage Trail

Following on from last year's successful 'Creative Stations of the Cross' event, each of our churches will be creating a Station which will be on display from Saturday 28 February. Each station will be created from pictures, objects, sculptures etc and if last year is anything to go by there will be many creative and moving exhibits.

**We hope that you will be inspired to make a 'pilgrimage' along the valley, visiting one, some or all of the churches - walking, cycling, riding or by car.**

On Good Friday, April 3, all of the Stations will be transferred to Broad Chalke church and there will be a 'Stations of the Cross' service at 2.00pm, when the meaning of each station will be presented by a member of the relevant church through a prayer, poem or devotion. As last year we hope that this will be a very personal, creative and individual experience for all.
