Salisbury Cathedral Winter Lecture Series open to all

Salisbury Cathedral is running a special Winter Lecture series from October 2012 – February 2013 focusing on four topics which set the scene and context of life in the Cathedral today.

On Wednesday 17th October Professor Claire Cross discusses the impact of the Reformation and Puritanism on life in Salisbury. On Wednesday 14th November Professor David Catchpole and Canon Tom Clammer describe the theology of Christmas and the way this great feast is celebrated in Salisbury Cathedral and elsewhere. On Wednesday 23rd January Professor John Harper explains the liturgy used in the Cathedral, the 'Use of Sarum', which profoundly influenced English patterns of worship. Finally on Wednesday 27th February The Bishop of Sherborne, the Rt Revd Graham Kings, explores John Jewel's role as Bishop of Salisbury and as a leader in defining the new post-Reformation Anglicanism.

The lectures in the North Transept at Salisbury Cathedral begin at 11.00am, except for the lecture on 14th November which begins at 10.30am. Tickets, £5.00 per lecture, are available online from www.salisburycathedral.org.uk from Monday 3 September.
