## Odstock Parish Council

### Annual Parish Meeting

OPC Chairman, Cllr Rod Poynting, delivered his report on the Parish Council's activities during the year. Eight Kissing Gates had been installed along the parish's footpath network and a grant had been secured from Hill's Waste Management to carry out repairs and improvements to the river-bank at Jubilee Gardens. This project is due to start during May 2013. The Odstock Play Area project has been delayed because funding has not been forthcoming.

NPT Community Beat Manager PC Matt Holland and NPT Sergeant David Lennane were both in attendance and Matt Holland stressed how helpful it is when local people are able to report the presence of unfamiliar vehicles in the parish. Vigilance is the best protection against random rural crime and the Neighbourhood Policing Team aim to be in regular contact with Landowners and Gamekeepers. The owners of outbuildings and land vulnerable to fly-tipping need to be particularly observant and report unusual activity on either 999 or the non-emergency 101 number.

### Annual OPC Meeting

This meeting followed the Annual OPC Meeting, following the APM on 9 May, Cllr Rod Poynting was re-elected as OPC Chairman and Cllr Stephen Stapley was elected as Vice-Chairman. The OPC accounts for y/e March 2013 revealed expenditure of £10,190.57p and income of £9291.89p. The balance to be carried forward is £10,629.67p. The formation of a Community Speed Watch group is a council priority and up to 8 volunteers are being sought to receive police training. Only two people are needed to operate the equipment at any one time, however, best results are achieved by rotating duties amongst the group. The next OPC meeting is planned for Thursday, 4 July.
