Last month, during a service of Morning Prayer, the people of Britford received a written report on St Peter's fabric, memorials and furnishings. This had been painstakingly compiled by the local members of NADFAS (National Association of Decorative and Fine Arts Societies) with help from members of the local congregation.

During his address on that occasion, The Rev'd Philip Lenon said that everything in the church was a record of the lives and deeds of those who had gone before us and whose lives, like ours, had been touched by *the* record - the Gospel of the life, death and resurrection of our Lord.

All our church buildings have their "stories to tell" and perhaps you have your favourite tablet or architectural feature. Perhaps for many of us the war memorials will touch us most deeply and be the most evocative as they relate to our own times and experiences.

A particularly effective memorial in Britford is that to various members of the Newman family who died in the first half of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. The wording concludes like this: "This tablet is erected by their Niece, Mary Ann Attwater, in testimony of her grateful sense of the uniform and parental affection she ever experienced from the above named relatives."

When I read those words, I find that the affection and love to which they refer comes to life and is still present. In a very real way what has been recorded 150 years ago breathes into me (the true meaning of "inspires") a sense of thanksgiving for Godly and human love.

Nothing good is lost - everything finds its record also in heaven. One day everything, including a record of your life and mine, will come into a great unity before our Creator. Let's live our lives accordingly that the record we leave may be read by others in the future and be a blessing to them!
